## **Drowning in Concern?**

I can hear some of you now:

Should I not be concerned? Well, of course, I should, but it's so easy to get overwhelmed by all the concerns around me! As I look around me, I see a world of brokenness, with more needs within my reach than I can ever meet. I already feel paralyzed by concern for more than I can handle, and now I'm supposed to be concerned for the unreached, the persecuted, youth everywhere, newcomers and the city? Help!

To be honest, the five groups our plenary sessions are focusing on this weekend are just a sample of all that God is concerned for and all that He calls the Church to care about. But His call is not meant to bring more stress into our lives; it is an invitation to step into the concerns of a Sovereign, wise, loving and powerful Lord. I am not the one to solve all the world's problems: God is sovereign, and has chosen to include us in His work.

"Do not be anxious about anything, but by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7). If our concerns are not grounded in prayer and trust in a Sovereign, wise Lord, then we will experience anxiety and miss out on seeing His hand at work among us.

As Executive Director for Missionfest Manitoba, I am acutely aware of two things: I am completely inadequate for this position, yet God has called me to lead MFM in this season. Daily, I need to look to the Lord for strength and guidance, clinging to His promise that "My strength is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Cor. 12:9). He continues to be faithful, as He will be to all who are obedient when He calls.

Furthermore, none of us need to (or can) carry all the concerns of the world. God's invitation is to the whole Church to be His hands and feet in the world, not to a select few. For my situation, the Lord has provided an excellent team to work with. All that happens this weekend would not be possible without them. "God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose." (1 Cor. 12:18). We are to work in concert with one another, you can't do everything. Nor should you.

One time, Brenda and I had the opportunity to meet a member of the Thai royal family who had dedicated her life to improving education in Thailand. While there, Brenda mused, "What would I do if I had the luxury of doing anything I wanted?"

The answer? Exactly what we were doing: Bringing the Good News of Jesus to the Thai people! It was a joy and privilege to take our small part in this amazing work of being ambassadors for Christ (2 Cor. 5:20).

Should I not be concerned? This question is first and foremost about God's concern for us and for those He has created (i.e. everyone!). He has given the Church a mandate to "make disciples of all nations," with each of us seeking to find that place in His work that He has prepared in advance for us to do (Eph. 2:10). It is our prayer that this weekend you may discover your place in this amazing work of reconciling the world to the Lord. God has created you unique: Will you trust Him enough to seek out that place He has prepared for you?
